### LEAGUE FEE INFORMATION

Men's League - \$390.00 per team (1 umpire)

Coed League - \$410.00 per team (1 umpire)

League fee is based on 8 games per team plus season-end tournament

### REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

Registration may be done in person, over the phone with a credit card, or online. North Kansas City Parks and Recreation office is located in the Lower Level of the NKC Public Library, 2251 Howell, North Kansas City, MO. A NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of \$50.00 is due at registration. Balance of the league fee is due on Friday, June 30. Non-payment by June 30 will result in loss of deposit and spot in the league. Team registration includes team name, contact person's name, address, work and home telephone numbers and completed roster with player waivers.

### MANAGER'S MEETING

Game schedules will be distributed at the manager's meeting on Wednesday, July 12, at the Parks and Recreation Office, 2251 Howell. Managers of coed teams will meet at 6:00 p.m.; men's teams meet at 6:30 p.m. League rules and procedures will be discussed at the manager's meeting. It is mandatory that each team is represented at the manager's meeting.

### LEAGUE INFORMATION

COED Evening Leagues will be offered on: Sundays – Game Times are based on number of teams.

MEN'S Evening Leagues will be offered on: Thursdays – Game Times are based on number of teams.

### LEAGUE NOTES

The fall season will begin July 20<sup>th</sup> for Men and July 16<sup>th</sup> for Coed and continue for five weeks with two additional weeks scheduled for rainouts. Each team will play **two games per week (double-header)** on their designated league evening.

All leagues will be D level. D leagues are for new teams and for teams playing at a recreational level.

All games are played at Macken Park.

Teams will be required to purchase their own game balls. Game balls must be A.S.A stamped, red-stitched, yellow optic ball. The Men's Softball is a 12 inch, .52 core, 300lbs compression ball and the Women's is an 11 inch .44 core, 375lbs compression ball.

Each eight-team league will play an eight game round robin. Each league will then be split based on win-loss record, into upper and lower divisions. Each division will play in a tournament for a minimum of 9 games played for the season.

Rainouts will be made up as time and scheduling permit. Every effort will be made to re-schedule games. Two weeks are added to the five weeks and are set aside for makeup games.

Awards will be given to the winners of the upper and lower division based on all games played.

The winning teams of the postseason tournament will be declared the champion.
