

SUMMARY OF ACTIONS TAKEN AT THE CITY OF NORTH KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

October 4, 2016

Work Session

There was no work session on October 4th.

Consent Agenda

- **Short-term Conditional Use Permit - Safe Haven Security Corporate Event**

Safe Haven Security has requested a Short Term Conditional Use Permit for a corporate event at 520 E 19th Avenue, which will be held on October 20 and 21. The event will last from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. each day and will consist of a private event with food and drinks. The event will be contained to the parking lot and two tents will be placed on the property. The applicant will be required to contact the Fire Department for inspection of the tents prior to the start of their event.

- **Community Planning Month Proclamation**

The celebration of National Community Planning Month gives us the opportunity to publicly recognize the participation and dedication of the members of the Planning Commission, the Board of Zoning Adjustment, and other citizens who have contributed their time and expertise to the improvement of the City of North Kansas City. This proclamation declares October 2016 as Community Planning Month in the City of North Kansas City.

Regular Items

- **Proclamation – Fire Prevention Week**

Mayor Stielow has proclaimed October 9 – 15 as Fire Prevention Week in North Kansas City.

- **Adoption of Salary Ranges for Calendar Year 2017**

The City's personnel policy provides that the City Council shall approve the City's overall job classification system, salary ranges, and general compensation strategy and plan. In its memo, staff recommends an increase in salary ranges for non-union-represented employees of 1.85%. A resolution has been prepared for Council consideration.

- **Riverbed Degradation Study – Fourth Amendment**

Since 2010, local public and private entities have been partnering financially on a 50:50 basis with the federal government on a U.S. Army Corps of Engineers study of the Missouri River riverbed degradation problem in the Kansas City area. This partnership has been coordinated by the Mid-America Regional Council (MARC). The various entities involved in funding the study over the years are asked each year to contribute a certain amount to accumulate the local match to the federal funding for the study. That amount varies according to the federal portion of the study in that year. In 2016, the federal portion of the study is \$165,000. MARC has requested that North Kansas City contribute \$10,000 in 2016 to this effort. The Fourth Amendment to the original contribution agreement with MARC has been prepared for Council consideration. Funding for the 2016 study is included in the 2016-2017 Budget.

- **Budget Amendment - Vernon Street Water Main Relocation**

The FY 2016 Water Fund budget contained a capital item to relocate the Vernon Street Water Main. The project was not accomplished in FY 2016, and was inadvertently not included in the FY 2017 Budget as a carryover project. The project is now ready to bid. A budget amendment appropriating the funds for this project in FY 2017 has been prepared for Council approval.

Approved.

- **Site-Specific Modification to 2012 International Building Code – 2900 Rock Creek Parkway**

Before the City Council for consideration is a request by Cerner Corporation for a site specific modification to the City Code to allow the alteration of a fire wall to equal or greater protection than what is stated in the 2012 International Building Code (IBC), which the City has adopted. In its memo, staff outlines the requested modification and recommends approval.

Approved.
