

## **Proposition P**

VOTE TUESDAY APRIL 4, 2023

On April 4, 2023 North Kansas City residents will be asked to vote on the following measure:

"Shall the City of North Kansas City, Missouri, impose a sales tax of one-quarter of one percent (1/4 of 1%) for the sole purpose of providing funding for local parks projects for the municipality?"

The last time voters in North Kansas City approved a sales tax increase was in 2017 for a 1/2 cent Public Safety Sales Tax. The proposed Park Sales Tax rate is 1/4 of one (1) cent that is projected to generate approximately \$800,000 per year.
