City Administrator Eric Berlin gave an overview of the Operations portion of the FY 2020-2021 Proposed Budget. Parks Director Kelli Votypka and Library Director Vickie Lewis reviewed their budgets with the Council. Discussion ensued. The following changes were indicated by Council to the Proposed Budget:

Proposed Budget --Operations

 Amend the General Fund to add \$5,000 to the Buildings and Grounds budget in the Public Spaces Maintenance line item. This is to fund the repair of the monument structures on 23rd Avenue Council Meeting Minutes September 2, 2020 Page 2

and Iron Street.

- Amend the Water Fund to deduct \$94,500 from the Professional Services line item. This is the amount of what was proposed as a contract for performing locates of fiber lines. The idea will be brought to the City Council at a future time.
- Amend the Water Pollution Control Budget to deduct \$9,500 for the Lab Water Filtration System capital project. This project was included in error for the FY 2021 Budget, as it was accomplished in FY 2020.
